NOTICE TO SPECIAL MILK CLASS PERMIT HOLDERS

NEW WEB-BASED REPORTING SYSTEM FOR SPECIAL MILK CLASS PERMIT HOLDERS

The Canadian Dairy Commission (CDC) has developed a new web-based reporting system that will simplify the reporting of milk ingredient purchases and sales by further processors and distributors registered in the Special Milk Class Permit Program (SMCPP).

In the coming year, registered SMCPP Permit Holders will be directed to the new web-based system to supply information on line in order to maintain compliance with the program reporting requirements.

Permit holders will have increased access to information on their activities under the Program and this will speed up the data reconciliation process.

The new web-based system will employ the Government of Canada's GC Keys authentication process and industry-recognized encryption methods. Permit holders will be given access to the web-based reporting system 24 hours/day, 7 days/week to input information required under the SMCPP and to apply for new finished products.

Further details on the new milk ingredients reporting system (MIRS) will be available in the coming weeks.
